

Math 1301 Final Exam "Double-Take"

You have the opportunity (option) this semester to take the final exam **two** times. The first attempt will be given online using My Math Lab and the second attempt will be given with your regular class.

You must already be registered in My Math Lab with your own username and password in order to be able to take the online exam. The online exam will be given in selected electronic classrooms and you must sign up in advance in the Math Lab in N925 for one of these locations. There is limited seating so sign up early. The day of testing is **Wednesday May 5th beginning at 9:00 am.** You will report to your assigned location to take the exam and should allow at least 2.5 hours to complete it. Your exam score will be immediately recorded in your online grade book in My Math Lab.

The in-class exam will be taken with your regular class (check with your instructor for the day and time) and is a paper & pencil test using a scantron to record your answers. If you take both the online and the in-class exams, your best score will be your recorded grade for the exam. If you only take one of the exams, then that score will be your recorded grade for the exam. *Note:* Your instructor may require you take the in-class exam even if you take the online exam and score well. Check with your instructor.

Testing Guidelines

- Reporting time is 8:45 am to your assigned location; bring your UHD ID card
- Allow at least 2.5 hours to complete the exam
- A scientific calculator is allowed
- Scratch paper will be provided; but cannot be taken out of the testing area
- Cell phones are not allowed inside the testing area
- The test is a timed exam with a visible time remaining clock on the exam
- The test can be reviewed immediately after taking, but cannot be printed
