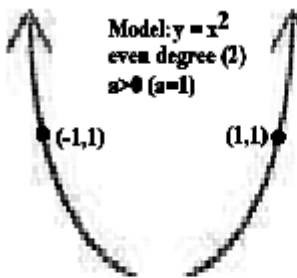
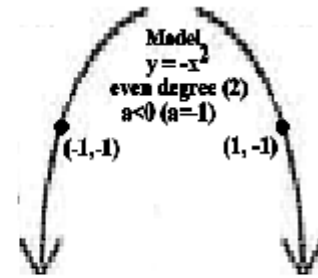
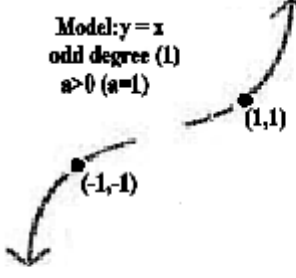
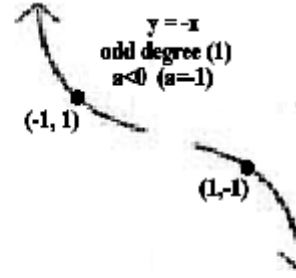


END BEHAVIOR of POLYNOMIAL GRAPHS
