Week	Activity	Important Dates
Orientation Week: Monday, June 3 to Friday, June 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Based on the level of your students and their expected background and knowledge of math and science, please choose two different projects, either from any of the links available on my Houston PREP PA Resources website at http://cms.uhd.edu/faculty/redlt/houstonprep/pa.html, or feel free to come up with your own! 	
Week 1: Monday, June 10 to Friday, June 14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce your students to the projects and share with them the project and poster guidelines and expectations from the Houston PREP PA Resources website Assign your students to groups of 3 or 4 students per group and have each group pick one of your selected projects on which to work. Provide students with “warm-up” problems to help them recall or learn concepts needed to work on the project. Let students begin working on the project. 	
Week 2: Monday, June 17 to Friday, June 21	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist students as they work on the project. Begin thinking of extensions to challenge students that may have already finished and be ready to move on. 	By Monday, June 17 , e-mail Dr. Redl the names of the projects that your class will be doing, along the number and size of groups doing each of the projects. Also let us know of anything you may need from us.
Week 3: Monday, June 24 to Friday, June 28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist students as they work on the project. Have students work on extensions of the problem, if applicable. Students can begin work on their project group posters this week. 	By Monday, June 24 , e-mail Dr. Redl with the status of the students’ progress on their projects. Are they grasping the concepts or struggling? Is each student involved in the project? Any concerns?
Week 4: Monday, July 1 to Friday, July 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist students as they work on the project and extensions. 	By Monday, July 1 , e-mail Dr. Redl with a status update.
Week 5: Monday, July 8 to Friday, July 12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student groups share their posters with the rest of the class during peer review sessions. Provide feedback to each group. Students will present their posters to the entire PREP program on either Thursday, July 20 or Friday, July 21.* 	By Wednesday July 10 , all groups should have presented to their class. *The final PREP program will be on either Thursday, July 11 or Friday, July 12.
